Advanced Aero-medical Transport Three Day Course

Increased specialisation within the NHS and the continuing congestion on the nation's road network, means that choosing the most appropriate method of transport for High Dependency or Long Distance hospital transfers can be daunting. For healthcare professionals in remote locations aero-medical transport offers a vital lifesaving service. The question most healthcare professionals would ask is where do I begin? This course will give you the answers...

Course Aim

To enable medical staff to make an informed decision about the most appropriate method of transport for each individual patient based on their medical need and teach them how to safely perform an aero-medical transfer.

Who should attend?

All medical professionals who may be involved in long distance or high dependency transfers.

The course is a mixture of theory and practical sessions including flights in both fixed wing and rotary wing air ambulances

This advanced course is similar to the 2 day basic aero medical transfer course but incorporates an additional 3rd day which is dedicated to working in and around helicopters.

Course Objectives are to:

- ❖ Define CAA regulations for HEMS and Air Ambulance work.
- ❖ Recognise appropriate methods of transport v distance.
- ❖ Understand and practise safety procedures in both rotary and fixed wing aircraft.
- ❖ Recognise emergency procedures in the event of a crash or forced landing.
- ❖ Demonstrate competency preparing patients for aero-medical transfer.
- ❖ Recognise CRM issues when performing an aero-medical transfer.
- ❖ Demonstrate competency working in and around helicopters.
- ❖ Demonstrate competency loading / unloading patients on rotary and fixed wing aircraft.
