Basic Aero-medical Transport Two Day Course

Who should attend?

All medical professionals who may be involved in long distance or high dependency transfers.

The course is a mixture of theory and practical sessions including a familiarisation flight in a fixed wing air ambulance.

Course Aim:

To enable medical staff to make informed decisions about the most appropriate method of transport for each individual patient based on their medical needs and to teach how to safely perform an aero-medical transfer.

Course Objectives are to:

- ❖ Define national regulations for Helicopter Emergency Medical Services and Air Ambulance
- ❖ Recognise appropriate methods of transport v distance
- ❖ Understand safety procedures in both rotary and fixed wing aircraft
- ❖ Recognise emergency procedures in the event of a crash or forced landing
- ❖ Demonstrate competency preparing patients for aero-medical transfer
- ❖ Demonstrate competency loading - unloading patients on fixed wing aircraft.
- ❖ Recognise Crew Resource Management issues when performing an Aero Medical Transfer

Accreditation:

This programme can lead to accreditation by the University of Northumbria, following successful completion of the full assessed element of the programme.

Cost: £550.00 includes overnight accommodation in Oxford. Students are expected to make their own way to Oxford. Oxford is approximately 1 hour to the west of London Heathrow and approx.2 hours from London Gatwick airports.
